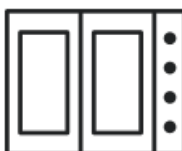
GENERAL CAUTIONS:

Instructions:

BAKE - CONVECTION

Instructions:
Preheat oven to 425°F. Spread frozen patties evenly on a shallow baking pan. Bake for 10 to 15 minutes, turning once for uniform cooking.
